First Sunday of Advent

Advent is a time of preparation with festivity. A joyful anticipation leading up to the celebration of the birth of our Savior and awaiting his return and our entrance into our true and eternal home. Advent encourages us to make room for the divine virtues of hope, peace, joy, and love through repentance and joyful service to our King. The Parable of the Traveling Landlord teaches us to be watchful, awake, and prepared for the return of the Lord (Mk. 13:33-37). The Landlord (Jesus) is going abroad (to heaven). He leaves his servants in charge; each with his own job. The purpose of the life of man is to know and love God (CCC 1-2). The gatekeeper is ordered to watch for the master's unknown time of return; then alert the servants to the master's arrival. In turn, the servants remain ready to receive the master properly at any moment. Additionally, the gatekeeper watches for dangers that threaten the estate. Likewise, we must be on the lookout for enemies to our salvation. We are to watch and pray so not to fall into temptation (Mt 26:41). Shun immorality of the body as it defiles the temple of the Holy Spirit (1 Cor. 6:18-19). Watch for those who cause divisions and put obstacles up that are contrary to Christ's teachings (Rm 16:17). Be ready to stand firm in the Faith (1 Cor 16:13) and give the devil no place (Eph 4:27). "What I say to you, I say to all: Watch!"

Watchfulness is single-mindedness. Care for your salvation and joyfully serve the Lord in your marriage and family or single life. Our relationships should be a hymn of praise to the newborn King. We have individual gifts for building up the body of Christ. Begin to get into a state of readiness (equals happiness) for the Lord and stay there. Make it a prayerful adventure to discover your talents and live your purpose to know and love God. Enjoy planning some great movies, service activities, family Holy hour, and prayer time. Take advantage of the Sacrament of Confession. As you immerse yourself in the Lord you will find divine graces and the virtues of hope, peace, joy, and love. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak and uninterested in what truly matters and what will ultimately be the only thing that remains. "O taste and see that the Lord is good! Happy is the man who takes refuge in him!" (Ps 34:8) How will you prepare?


