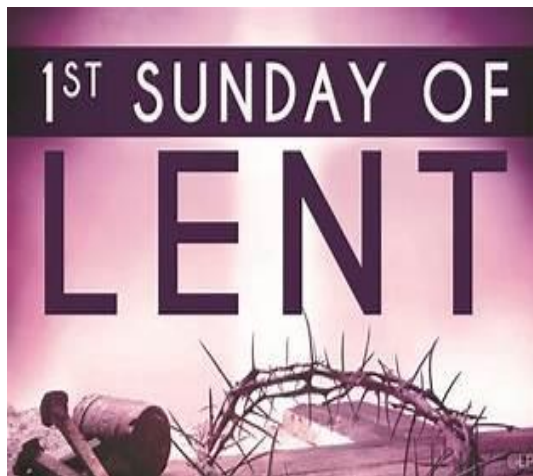

First Sunday of Lent

Lent is a time of alms giving, prayer, and fasting to prepare for the celebration of the Pascal Mystery (the death and resurrection of Christ) and continue the process of conversion. A time of repentance that brings us closer to God so that His desires become ours. When thinking about almsgiving, remember what is important to God: Share your bread with the hungry, shelter the oppressed and the homeless; clothe the naked when you see them, and do not turn your back on your own (Isaiah 58:7-10). Today we reflect on the temptation of Christ (Mt 4:1-11). Jesus fasted and prayed for 40 days and nights to prepare for His ministry. Prayer and fasting are a powerful combination against wickedness and a source of spiritual strength. Surely, this is why Satan tempted Christ to break His fast by turning stones into bread and, causing Christ to turn away from God's plan of salvation. Jesus used the scripture to answer every suggestion the devil made and remained faithful to God. He was tempted in every respect yet did not sin so he can sympathize with our weaknesses (Heb 4:15). Satan twisted the meaning of the scripture to serve his purpose. After Jesus repeatedly resisted the devil, he left. It is what scripture teaches us to do when the devil comes. "Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you" (James 4:7). Finally, angels came to minister to Christ. Just as God sent angels to tend to Christ, we too can count on divine consolation from God.

Overcoming temptation allows us to experience and walk in the fruits of the Holy Spirit (love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control) giving us the ability to serve God better and truly enjoy life. Jesus is our example; fast, pray, resist, speak, and know the word so not to be deceived. Prayerfully reading and meditating on the daily readings renews the mind and provides powerful words to ward off the enemy. Prayer connects us to God and fills us with power from the Holy Spirit to overcome. "For the weapons of our warfare are not worldly but have divine power to destroy strongholds" (2 Cor 10:4). Fasting shows repentance, subdues fleshly desires, and strengthens our Spirit. Frequent repentance and reconciliation restore grace, give power, and reduce sin's influence. Finally, following Isaiah 58:7-10 in alms giving, caring for the needy, our neighbor, and families bring our actions in line with the will of God and provide divine strength (Jn 4:32). How will you prepare during Lent?

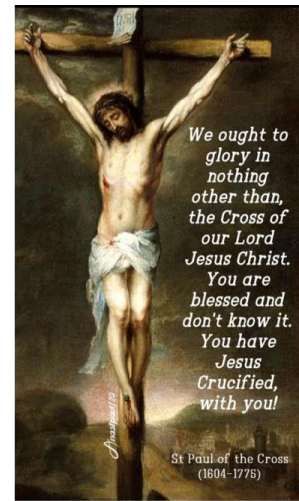
