Palm Sunday

On Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion, we celebrate Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem but also commemorate the beginning of Holy Week and Jesus' final journey to the cross. This reflection focuses on the holy procession into Jerusalem (Mk 11:1-10). When Jesus and the disciples near Jerusalem, he sends two disciples ahead: "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately on entering it, you will find a colt tethered on which no one has ever sat. Untie it and bring it here." As the Son of God, Jesus had precise foreknowledge of the colt and gives the disciples a response for anyone asking why they want the animal: "The Master has need of it and will send it back here at once." Everything unfolds as Jesus described and they bring the colt to Jesus and cover it with their cloaks. He mounts the colt and adoration breaks out among the crowd. Moved by His presence, they cover the road with their cloaks and cut tree branches, an honor reserved for kings and others deemed worthy of this highest honor. They cry out in homage: " Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Blessed is the kingdom of our father David that is to come! Hosanna in the highest." It is the fulfillment of the Messianic prophecy of Zechariah: "Rejoice heartily, O daughter Zion, shout for joy, O daughter Jerusalem! See your king shall come to you: a just savior is he, meek, and riding on an ass, on a colt, the foal of an ass" (9:9).

Jesus has awakened great hope and joy in the hearts of the people that have met and heard about Him. His unfathomable love has reached out to the humble, poor, forgotten, lepers, sick, demon possessed, and despised. Jesus has brought healing, forgiveness, freedom from demons, new lifestyles, and most importantly eternal salvation. His divine teachings were new. Teachings spoken with authority and accompanied by many signs and wonders. Jesus reached out to body and soul. He was God but lowered himself to walk with them and us. He is our friend, brother, the light to our path, the joy of our salvation. Ours is not a joy of having possessions but from having encountered Jesus. We are never alone even in the most difficult times. "If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full" (Jn 15:10-11). Have you encountered Jesus?


