3rd Sunday of Lent

In the gospel (Jn 2:13-25), Jesus shakes up the sacrificial system of animal offering and puts his Father's house in order. The Temple was the most important building in Jewish life. A place God instructed his people through Scripture and received their worship. Jesus found the Temple lacking reverence for God and quickly made a whip out of cords and drove all the merchants and their animals out of the temple area. He overturned their tables and spilled the coins of the money changers. To those selling doves he said, "Take these out of here, and stop making my Father's house a marketplace." In calling God his Father Jesus reveals his true relationship (Son) to God and implies his authority to correct the situation. The disciples remembered the Scripture, "Zeal for your house will consume me;" the reason Jesus was crucified. The priests respond: "What sign can you show us for doing this?" Jesus answered, "Destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up." The priests take this to mean the structure (the Temple), but Jesus spoke about his body as God's temple and his death and resurrection as the sign that God sanctioned everything Jesus said and did. The apostles didn't understand this until the Holy Spirit recalled the Scripture "Zeal for your house will consume me" after the Resurrection. It caused them to believe all the Scripture and words Jesus had spoken. Jesus remained for the feast of Passover. Many started to believe in Jesus due to "signs" he did. Jesus did not trust himself to them because he "knew them all" and understood human nature well. They believed Jesus because of the miracles but had no interest in the message of salvation.

Looking back at the Cleansing at the Temple knowing what happened afterward, it's easy to see Jesus replaced the Temple as the center of worship and the animal sacrifices with His single sacrifice for all on the cross. Jesus was the temple of God then; now our bodies are temples for the Holy Spirit if we believe in redemption through Christ and are baptized. Just as Jesus put things in order at the Temple, Scripture and the Holy Spirit continue to change our wrong ideas of Faith and cause us to believe and act on His word. The Holy Spirit draws us into a deeper, more fruitful relationship with Christ so that we increase in zeal for the kingdom and put our salvation above any other priority. The gospel directs us to repent of sin done through our body (house of God), recognize Jesus' divine authority, be cleansed by repentance and reconciliation, and allow grace to increase obedience to His word in our life. How is the Holy Spirit prompting you to clean house?

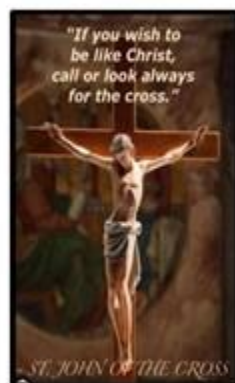

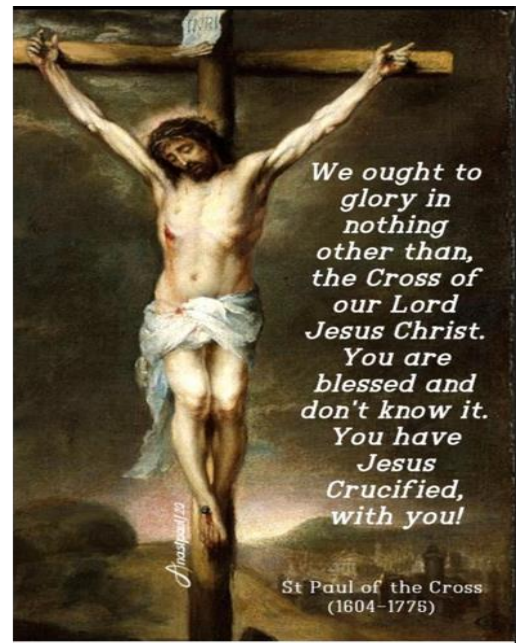

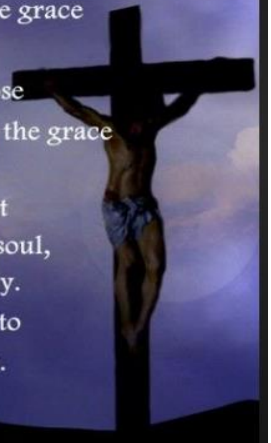
