## **GOSPEL MEDITATION**


"You say I am a king."

When I was a young boy in Burlington, Vermont, my dad had a good friend named Phil who owned a sporting goods store. I loved sports, so wandering the treasure-filled aisles was an unmitigated joy. One afternoon, we were shopping for a baseball glove, Dad said to me, "Hey Johnny, see that man who just walked into the store?" That's Phil, "I remember being fascinated and a little terrified. I recall thinking, "That man right there is in charge of everything in this store!" He reigned over every ball, sneaker, jersey, and sweat suit. Phil became a family friend. And he was a good owner. The store flourished and I found myself even more at peace every time I went there. I felt a new hope and even responsibility for the store to flourish.
